TERMS & CONDITIONS

WHO CAN ENTER

1. The “*Connecting Generations*” competition (“Competition”) is open to all residents of the Galson Estate and also to those who work on Galson Estate. Any entrant under the age of 18 years must have permission from their parent or legal guardian, who is over 18, to enter the competition.
2. Entries remain the property of the entrant. By submitting an entry, entrants grant Urras Oighreachd Ghabhsainn (UOG) permission for their entry to be published online and in print. The entrant grants UOG a limited non-exclusive, irrevocable, perpetual and royalty-free copyright licence to reproduce and modify submitted images (including in electronic format, hard copy and in the publications) for purposes connected with the work of UOG.

WHAT TO ENTER

3. UOG is committed to celebrating the diversity of grandparents and older people, and their contribution to the community, by challenging stereotypes and promoting positive representations. For the competition, we are looking for images (traditional or alternative in composition) that share the talent and experience of grandparents and older people. Each image must include an older person as a subject. Entries may originate in any format - including but not limited to digital files, digital prints, colour transparencies, colour prints, or black and white prints - so long as they are submitted electronically in a .jpeg form.

Caption information should include:

- Photo Title - a name for your photo!
- Photographer’s name, age, phone & email
- Name and age of subjects
- Location of photo (even if it isn’t taken on the Galson Estate)
- Detailed caption 50-word statement providing insight into the image and its subjects.

HOW TO ENTER

4. Entries will be accepted from **Thursday 19th of July** and must be received no later than 5.00pm on **Monday 20th August** (“Competition Period”). To enter, entrants must email: office@uogltd.com and include “Connecting Generations” in the subject title of the email.

PRIVACY

UOG collects personal information in order to conduct the competition. The provision of personal information is voluntary. If you decline to provide your personal information you will not be eligible to participate in the competition or exhibition.
